

Part-time Weekend Instructor for International Student Program – Arts & Entertainment

The *Arts & Entertainment* Au Pair Weekend program is seeking energetic individuals to assist with an intensive weekend program in Los Angeles for international students / au pairs. We are seeking qualified instructors with experience in the fields of entertainment and the arts, as well as teaching and international experience.

Program Instructor / Part-time Faculty Overview:

- Work 4 weekends per year (Friday morning through Sunday afternoon with a possible staff meeting before each weekend class). The number of hours worked each weekend may vary depending on staffing and enrollment.
- Serve as the "homeroom" teacher for one section of 25-40 students / weekend class.
- Track and monitor students within section for attendance and assignments.
- Prepare for and teach several lectures (curriculum provided), including topics of:
 - Creativity, L.A. Culture and History, Performing Arts in L.A., Visual Arts in L.A., and Hollywood's Influence on Global and Popular Culture
- Facilitate in-class presentations, creativity-based activities, and group discussions.
- Lead student groups on the out-of-class educational and community excursions, including walking tours, museum, and other activities relevant to the performing and visual arts.
- Assist as needed (including logistics & food) to ensure weekend runs smoothly.

Requirements

- Master's degree required, preferably in a field related to the course curriculum.
- Experience and interest in the fields of arts and entertainment required, including performing arts (drama, TV/film, music) and/or visual arts (art, architecture, photography).
- Teaching experience required, preferably in a higher education setting.
- Ability to take initiative and modify teaching to the needs of diverse students.
- Organized and ability to lead students both in and out of the classroom setting.
- Passion and enthusiasm that brings energy to the program.
- International experience preferred, preferably living abroad experience.
- Familiarity in excursion locations strongly preferred: Westwood/UCLA campus, Downtown L.A., Hollywood, etc.

Course/Work Schedule

The next course date is December 8-10. There will be four weekends per year starting in 2018. Weekends in 2018 and moving forward will likely be held June 14-16, August 10-12, October 5-7, and Dec 14-16. 2018.

A full weekend contract for instructors consists of 40 hours: 30 teaching/facilitating hours for the weekend, plus 10 additional work hrs (6 hrs prep including arriving/departing 30 minutes before and after each class day, and one hour per teaching day for additional class preparation; 2 hrs Friday work and staff meeting before class starts, up to 2 hrs Sunday afternoon after class ends, or outside of class hours). Weekend class hours: Friday 10:30 am - 9:30pm (staff arrives by 8:30 am for staff meeting); Saturday 9 am - 9:30 pm; Sunday 9 am - 4:30 pm (staff to leave 5:30 or 6). Depending on staffing and enrollment needs, instructors may work on an hourly basis rather than a full weekend contract.

Compensation

Instructors are hired initially on a trial-basis as independent contractors (1099) and complete training weekends prior to being fully compensated as a regular instructor. Compensation information as follows:

- Training #1, 30-hour class from Friday through Sunday (first weekend) = \$800. This includes a 40-hour commitment (see work schedule above). If you are hired on an hourly basis, your training pay will be \$23/hr.
- After completion of one full training weekend (40 hours), or 2 weekends of working a partial weekend (anything less than 32 hours) with Au Pair Weekend, compensation increases to \$1100 per weekend (pro-rated at \$27.50/hour).
- After your training period, if you are fully available to APW, but APW does not offer you a full weekend contract for a given weekend due to lower enrollments, your time will be paid at \$30/hour.
- If you are not available for a full weekend contract, your pay will be pro-rated hourly based on your current compensation level. If you are unavailable for too much of a weekend, then it may be necessary to find additional staff, which means we would not be able to guarantee pro-rated weekends.
- APW will pay a daily minimum of \$100 for instructors who work on an hourly basis.
- Upon completion of 4 complete weekends (or working at least 4 partial weekends with 100 hours minimum), and the ability to teach all the academic courses in the program, an annual increase of \$2/hr is provided. Compensation continues to increase by \$2/hr yearly, contingent upon completion of working 4 weekends and a minimum of 100 hours of work during the calendar year.
- APW staff in L.A. are eligible to receive up to \$50 reimbursement per weekend class (\$20/day on Fridays and Saturdays and \$10/day on Sundays) to cover parking or other travel-related costs and meals not provided on Friday or Saturday.

Staff reviews will be conducted on an annual (or more frequently as needed) basis, at which point the current compensation plan and job description will be reviewed and modified on an as needed basis.

NOTE: This same Au Pair Weekend *Arts & Entertainment* curriculum will be launching in New York City in Spring 2018 and L.A. staff with experience in NYC, and who have interest in traveling there, may be invited to assist with this program launch.
